Summary of the Project

Social gender equality is a fundamental principle of democracy and is one of the prerequisites of sustainable development. It is a reality that the path of strengthening society dynamics pass through to ensure more equal rights for men and women. At the European level, although there have been many improvements on women's social and economic rights, it is clear that gender equality is still not at desired level. Settled opinions and cultural understandings about opposite sexes in society are the important obstacles in front of achieving gender equality.

This Erasmus+ KA1 Mobility for Youth Workers project will gather 34 youth workers from programme countries. The 7 days of activity will be implemented in Isparta/Turkey. Participants of the project will be the youth workers active in youth field and having the economic, social and geographical disadvantages will be the main criterias for the participants' selection. In the project the participants will be able to identify the extent of the gender inequality in society and also experience a deeper level of understanding through cross cultural exchange. They will discuss about how to satisfy gender equality in EU, focusing on the opportunities for young people and sharing best practices. We will analyze the situation of each participants' country and will present some local best practices in order to share and establish new project ideas. During workshops; participants will develop a greater awareness of the gender roles and the existing cultural understandings about men and women. In group works; they will experience working as teams and during the dramas and simulations; they will have opportunity to see the events from the opposite sex's point of view. This project will enable participants to demonstrate their countries' culture and conditions of gender by using the presentations and exhibitions. Furthermore it will make contributions for young people to be open minded, to respect each other and opposite sex, to discover different cultural and social realities, to provide mutual learning and to strengthen the identity of European Citizenship

IMPORTANT POINTS

1. The tickets have to be from economical class.

3. Accommodation and food expenses will be totally covered by the project.
4. Please find participants and organize them until 07th of December 2017. We need participant forms until this date.
5. You can come to Turkey max.4 days before the activity starting date and leave max. 4 days after the activity finishing day. Please book your tickets accordingly.
6. Participants must be over 18 years old but There is no upper age limit
7. We are planning to organise one day excursion to Antalya, during the activity. The excursion costs 25 Euro for each participant. Participants are free to attend or not to the trip. Cost of excursion will be cut from travel expenses of participants.

HOW TO REACH ISPARTA

To reach to Venue place, you have 3 alternative airports.

1) Isparta Süleyman Demirel Airport

*It is a domestic airport and there are flights from only Istanbul Atatürk Airport. **If you find a flight on your travelling day you can directly come to Isparta airport. To search flights from Istanbul to Isparta airport please check the link below:**

*After you arrive at the airport take a shuttle to City Centre (drop off at the Bus Station to take another bus to Eğirdir.

2) Istanbul Airport(Atatürk Airport) (Sabiha Gokcen airport mostly domestic airport)

*There are two airports in Istanbul if you choose coming from Istanbul to Isparta by bus we recommend you to take Ataturk Airport because it is very easy to reach at bus terminal.

*If you land on Atatürk Airport and you want to come Antalya by plane, You have to take a plane from Ataturk airport. You can find domestic flight from Ataturk airport. Dont choose Sabiha Gokcen Airport. Because it is very far away from Sabiha Gokcen airport to Ataturk Airport.)

*To come from Atatürk airport to bus terminal there is an Underground Train(Metro) at the down stairs of the airport. Take on the train (0.5 Euro) and take off at the Esenler Bus Terminal. Bus price from Istanbul to Isparta is about 25 Euro. It takes about 8 hours.

3)Antalya airport(AYT)

*Antalya to Isparta is about 110 kms.

*From Antalya airport you take a service bus to Bus Terminal(about 5 or 6 Euro) Then at Bus Terminal you take a bus to preferably Eğirdir/. If you can not find a bus to Eğirdir you can buy your ticket to Isparta city center. (About 7,5 Euro). It takes about 2,5 hours.
